PURPOSE:

The State of Hawaii will use the funds to expand information capture and sharing capabilities to additional criminal justice agencies. It will use the funds to enhance information sharing among county and state agencies located in Hawaii County. In addition, the integrated county project established in Hawaii County will be replicated in Kauai County and the Honolulu Sheriff's Office, a division of the state's Department of Public Safety. Advantages of the system include making it paperless and eliminating duplicate data entry, allowing more immediate entry and retrieval of arrest/booking information, and converting to a system that conforms with industry and FBI standards.
