PURPOSE:

The State of Illinois will use the funds to increase efficiency and data integrity at all information exchange points within the state's criminal justice system. The state will identify and electronically bridge these information exchange points. This will prevent duplication of effort and unnecessary data re-entry, decreasing the possibility of human error and improving the timeliness and accuracy of criminal history data. The state will also use the funds to create a governing body that will work toward the development of an effective, integrated criminal justice information system. Additionally, Illinois will begin a needs assessment of its justice data systems to determine what needs to be done to achieve full integration.
