**PURPOSE:**

The State of Connecticut will use the funds for three projects: the Connecticut Crime Mapping Incident Database, the Department of Correction (DoC) Inmate Sentencing Automation, and Order Registry Integration Enhancement. The DoC Inmate Sentencing Automation project will eliminate manual recalculation of inmates' sentence length. The Order Registry Integration Enhancement project will expand data accessibility to restraining orders, protective orders, and no contact information throughout the Judicial Branch.

In addition to improving justice information sharing and integrating initiatives among the Connecticut justice agencies, the projects will provide data to the developing Connecticut Offender Based Tracking System (OBTS). OBTS will track an offender from the time of arrest to the time of release.
