The State of Missouri will use the funds to establish a governance structure to allow interagency sharing of criminal justice information. In addition, a research tool and methodology will be implemented to assist in the examination of information exchanges from a variety of perspectives. Also, the state will establish a real time link between the Department of Corrections and law enforcement, prosecution, defense, courts, probation, and parole. Finally, it will implement an integrated solution that complies with the emerging national definition of integration, which encompasses a variety of functions to enable the timely and efficient sharing of information within and between agencies.
