PURPOSE:

The Utah Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice will use the funds for three projects: the Offender Tracking System (O-TRACK), the Automated Office of the Courts information system (CORIS), and the Police Record Management Systems. The goal of all three projects is to provide data statewide to enhance the crime fighting efforts of Utah's justice agencies. O-TRACK is Utah's Department of Corrections' record management system, which tracks offenders in prison and on probation or parole from initial conviction through final release. CORIS is an information system that the Administrative Office of the Courts uses to track information about cases. The Police Record Management Systems are used by local criminal justice agencies to track cases and/or individuals through their section of the justice system.
