# DHS/DOJ Fusion Process Technical Assistance Program and Services

## Program Overview

To facilitate the development of national fusion process capabilities, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) partnered in 2007 to develop the Fusion Process Technical Assistance Program.

## Gap Mitigation Services

Federal, state, and local fusion center stakeholders share a common goal of supporting a nationwide capacity for receiving, analyzing, disseminating, and gathering threat information. The purpose of gap mitigation is to assist fusion centers in fully achieving and maintaining their capabilities in the Critical Operational Capabilities (COCs), the Enabling Capabilities (ECs), and additional areas.

**The Fusion Process Technical Assistance Program offers services, free of charge, to assist fusion centers with their gap mitigation efforts.**
